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**IMPORTANT
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The following information and requirements is presented to avoid violations of State of Wisconsin Statutes, rules and/or regulations regarding the procedure for obtaining and retention of the instruction (temporary) permit or license.

Upon completion of the classroom training the student is eligible to obtain their instruction (temps) license from the Department of Motor Vehicles at 15 ½ or older. After the student has their temps they may begin the Behind the Wheel training.

Requirements for Instruction Permit (Temps)

1. **Original Birth Certificate** or (One of the following)
 - a. **Certified Copy of the Original Birth Certificate** (Photo or Fax copies not accepted)
Obtain from the Register of Deeds office in the County and/ or State you were born.
 - b. **Passport**
 - c. **State of Wisconsin I.D. Card**
2. **Another form of identification**
 - a. Social Security Card (make sure you have signed it prior to arrival at DMV Office)
 - b. School ID
3. **(MV3001) Wisconsin Operators License Application.**
 - a. **Complete All Applicants Section and Answer Questions, Sign and Date (In Black or Blue Ink). Other Side Under 18 Only Read and Sign Applicant Certification.**
 - b. **NOTE: SPONSOR CERTIFICATION-** Parents signature must be notarized in section of the Sponsor Certification section of the form. DMV employees are all Notary Public.
4. **Fee of \$35.00 for Instruction Permit (temps).**
 - a. Make checks payable to: **Registration Fee Trust.**

ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS-Under Wisconsin State Statutes 215.2

ONLY THE FOLLOWING ARE ACCEPTABLE to obtain permit.

1. An original Birth Certificate
2. A certified copy of a Birth Certificate or the equivalent document from the State, Territory or Foreign Country of Birth.
3. A Passport
4. A Wisconsin Notification of Birth Registration or the equivalent from the State, Territory or Foreign Country of Birth.
5. A Wisconsin Identification Card (ID)

NOTE: HOSPITAL birth certificates or BAPTISMAL certificates are no longer acceptable proof of name, place and date of birth or **PROOF OF IDENTITY.**

Wisconsin Statute s.245.17 requires that the student begin the formal Behind the Wheel training no later than sixty (60) days from the date of issuance of the Instruction Permit (Temps). Students will be required to complete the formal Behind the Wheel training on or before the ORIGINAL Instruction Permit (TEMPS) expiration date or be dropped from the course.

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REQUIRMENTS FOR PROBATIONARY LICENSE (ROAD TEST)

1. Appointment is **required** to take the road test.

 - c. www.deckersdriving.com , click on forms, click on schedule a road test

You will need the following information when making the appointment.

- d. **Your Social Security Number.**
- e. **Your Birth Date.**
- f. **A phone number where you can be reached.**

On the day of the test you will need the following

2. 30 hours of logging (10 hours at night). Recorded and initialed as instructed.
3. Social Security number for MV-3001 Form
4. Fee of \$43.00. (Make checks payable to the REGISTRATION FEE TRUST.)
5. Your Instruction Permit (temps)
6. Class Completion Certificate (MV-3192) will now be filed electronically with the Department of Motor Vehicles. Except for students who have different schools attended for classroom and behind the wheel instruction.

NOTE: MV - 3001 Form fill out at DMV office.
This form will need to be signed again by parent or legal guardian
in the presence of a DMV officer for section of the sponsorship certification.
Does not need to be signed by the school for your probationary license.

FORMS: MV3001 and MV3192 are required by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

**** A Completion Certificate (MV3192) will NOT be issued or filed for any student who fails the course or who has not turned in all homework, projects or school issued materials or books, and all fees are paid.**
